








How is Europe addressing the challenges?

Mario Draghi: Europe is falling economically behind China and the USA

- → The Draghi Report proposes:
 - Increased opportunities for innovation
 - **Green transition** as a growth opportunity
 - Greater economic and security policy autonomy
 - More investments and fewer regulations
 - A focus on the EU's institutional structure
- = The EU's competitiveness must be strengthened
